COUNTY INSPECTOR'S OFFICE
WICKLOW 1st August 1914

I have to report:-

- I. This County still continues to be peaceful. There is no person under police protection. There is still the feeling of unrest over the state of affairs in the North and the political situation in general but it is not of an acute or dangerous character as yet. There was some ill-feeling exhibited towards the military in Camp here, among whom were several of the R.O.A. Boerwar, over the trials in Dublin last Sunday; but there were no assaults or any acts of violence committed. There are now 23 branches of the I.N.V. with a total membership of 2350 but a good many of the members

do not drill or take any active part in the movement.

II. There were three indictable offenses during the month none of them of a vicious character. There were two cases last month.

III. There were no sorceries during the month and no oaths sworn taken or surrendered during the month. The relations between landlord and tenant still continued satisfactory.

IV. The various branches of the N.S.L A.T.H and G.A.A were inactive during the month. There is a branch of the Senior Frat in Rosay but it is inactive.

V. There is no boycotting or intimidation in the County.

VI. There were five ^{public} meetings in connection

II. with the I.N.V. in different parts of
the County during the month but the
speeches were wild and the proceedings
quite peaceable. The prices of stock
are not varied but owing to the war
removal has been a rise in
the price of provision. Employment
still continues to be good.
